**Reminders for Water Runs:**

- **BEFORE**
- **WEATHER:** If it has rained or rain is imminent, check that the trip is still going out before driving to yard.
- **Trips start at 7:00 a.m.** unless okayed for another time with Rebecca. We have guests, reporters, students, etc. who participate in water runs and are counting on us to be there on the agreed time.
- **Please make sure Rebecca has your most current contact information.**
- **DURING**
- Please don't back up in the truck yard. We've had a number of minor accidents in the yard.
- **Turn on SPOT.** This gives us a perfect map of exactly where you are and creates a map of each trip.
- **If you see anything of a threatening nature, leave the site and call 911 and text Joel.**
- If a station is shot, stabbed, or stolen, take a photo and report to sherriff (see notebook).
- Be sure color tape and number stickers are correct (see sticker box).
- Take photos of each station after servicing.
- Take photos of BP vehicle plate if you think it is parked too close to our stations.
- **AFTER**
- **Turn off SPOT.**

- Be sure to complete trip report and clip gas receipt to clip board.
- Please note any broken equipment on the trip report.
- **Text Rebecca/Joel if the truck needs immediate repair.**
