Reminders for Water Runs:

- BEFORE
- WEATHER: If it has rained or rain is imminent, check that the trip is still going out before driving to yard.
- Trips start at 7:00 a.m. unless okayed for another time with Rebecca. We have guests, reporters, students, etc. who participate in water runs and are counting on us to be there on the agreed time.
